myself were at a meeting  
with numerous others. We

evident intention of keeping us outside, without showing from scripture that I could be wrong.

This is the point - but Kelly while admitting that the blood of others upon and before the Cross - See immediately the Lord Jesus died, holds that Propitiation was made on the Cross - I think he is correct P there was need of a Sanctuary - a Priest, and blood - To become Priest the Lord Jesus had to die Heb 8:4 - all for P to be made by His blood done

had first to take place, Heb 9.12.  
Therefore it was made in the  
Heavenly Sanctuary by the Lord  
Jesus not before, but, I think, after  
death. So you see the difference  
is, on the one hand with and  
others hold Propitiation (or the  
sprinkling of the ~~blood~~ once upon  
the mercy seat) made on the cross.  
On the other hand, I think not,  
but as already mentioned in  
the Heavenly Sanctuary, Heb 2.17  
(for reconciliation read Pro: R.O.)  
and 9.11.12.
