Lord Ebury - aged 95 -
recalls his schoolfellows.

Moor Park Rickmansworth

13 Sept 1893.

Sir

I have received your letter of the 9th, and in reply have to say that Darby, the individual I presume you mean (I am not sure of his Xian name) was a schoolfellow and a friend of mine. He was a good cricket and raquet player, but as to his scholarships I am not able to speak, for in those days no one cared much about that, except they were going to stand out for college. He subsequently married a sister of Sir Samuel Hedger.
