WILLIAM HENRY DARBY of Leap Castle, M.A. Barrister-at-Law. Born 1790; married first, Laura Charlotte, dtr of Ed. Jeremiah Curteis, Esq of Windmill Hill, Sussex and by her (she died 27 Mch. 1847) had issue,
